

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Payment

This workshop is costed in Euros and that is thus the only constant price due to the fluctuations of the exchange rate prices in other currencies. Payment for this workshop is handled by our partners at Iceland Travel.

In order to secure your place on this workshop a 20% deposit must be paid at the time of the booking. The remainder of the total holiday price is to be paid 4 weeks (28 days) prior to arrival in Iceland. If payment is not received 28 days prior to arrival, Iceland Travel will treat this as a cancellation of the booking and withdraw its confirmation of services. For all bookings made within 30 days prior to arrival to Iceland, a full payment must be made at the time of the booking.

Iceland Travel accepts Visa, MasterCard and American Express.

Cancellation

A cancellation must be sent by e-mail, and needs to be confirmed by Iceland Travel in order to be valid. In conformity with business practices within the Icelandic travel industry, the traveller is required to pay cancellation fees on the total price as follows:

More than 3 weeks (22+ days) prior to arrival	20%
3 weeks (21 days) and more than 1 week (8 days)	50%
1 week (7 days) and more than 72 hours	75%
72 hours' notice and less	100%

However, the deposit is fully refundable if we can fill your place

We reserve the right to cancel a workshop in case of insufficient enrolment which might make the tour financially unviable, or due to concerns about the potential safety and welfare of participants. In these instances we offer a full refund of all payments made to us by current participants of the workshop, or people who have cancelled within 7 days of our cancellation of the workshop. In the highly unlikely case that we need to cancel a trip in progress due to concerns about the safety and welfare of workshop participants, you will receive a refund proportional to the amount of time remaining on the workshop.

We aren't responsible for any refund of airline tickets purchased directly by the participant.

Health

This workshop is designed to be within the capabilities of the average person in good health. Participants will be required to walk over uneven terrain or trails and may occasionally need to hike to a destination while carrying their camera equipment. Any physical condition requiring special treatment should be communicated to us before enrolling in the workshop. If you have concerns about your own capabilities and/or fitness as it relates to this workshop, please contact us to clarify any uncertainties.

Itinerary

While we will make every effort to follow the itinerary laid out in the workshop documentation, we reserves the right to make changes or modifications due to weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances.

Insurance

We do not provide insurance and strongly recommend you take out adequate travel insurance, health insurance, accident insurance, mountain rescue insurance, personal liability insurance for the duration of your journey. This insurance should be valid for the location and time where and when the tour is to be held.

All participants to the workshops should be aware that by taking part in a tour you may run certain risks related to travel, transportation, outdoor activities, eventual remoteness of medical facilities, etc. You must therefore, bear all risks you may be involved with (injuries, property damage, death, medical expenses, repatriation expenses, transportation costs for abandonment of the tour, economic losses, etc.), and hereby release us and agree to not hold us responsible for any and all liability, actions, causes of actions, debts, claims, and demands of every kind and nature in connection with your participation in any tour arranged by us. The terms hereof shall serve as a release and assumption of all risk by you, your heirs, executors and administrators, and for all members of your family.

If you have any dietary requirements or requests you should inform us at the time of booking. We will advise the lodges/hotels but we do not assume responsibility for the delivery of such special dietary requirements.

Responsibility

We will not bear any responsibility for services that are beyond our control, such as lifts, huts, mountain cabins, hotels, restaurants, airlines, guides and transportation companies.
